Morah Ronit and her Hey class (5th grade) started learning about the geography of Israel. They created a classroom reference map and each of them created their own map with the information they discussed.



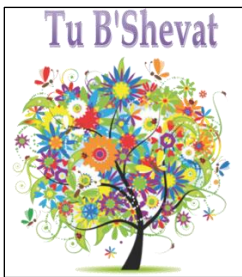
### ***Confronting Anti-Semitism - January 13***

## ***Learn with Miriam - Save the Date - Wednesdays in February***



Join rabbinic intern Miriam Geronimus for a 6-part series on eco-Judaism. The series will begin with an exploration of how science relates to Jewish tradition. We will then look more closely at ecology and environmentalism from a Jewish perspective. Our primary question will be: what is our relationship to the rest of Creation? We will ask this question by looking at Torah; Talmud and Midrash; Kabbalah (Jewish Mysticism); and contemporary Jewish thinkers. We will also examine this question through the lenses of narrative, prayer, and ritual. Attendance at all 6 sessions is recommended but not required. The sessions will meet Wednesdays evenings in February and twice in March. The class is scheduled for 6-7:30 p.m. February 6, 13, 20, 27, March 6 and March 27. The first and fifth classes will go until 7 and the 20<sup>th</sup> may be rescheduled due to a board meeting.
