
## **Community Tisha b'Av Services**

Tifereth Israel at 2909 Bristol Rd. in Bensalem will be hosting the community service for Erev Tisha b'Av, Saturday night, July 21. Services will start at 9 PM with Maariv, Havdalah and then a reading of the book of Eicha (Lamentations). On Sunday July 22, the Community Tisha b'Av services move to Congregation Beth El at 375 Stony Hill Rd. in Yardley for Shacharit (8AM) and Mincha (1 PM).

Tisha B'Av — the 9th day of the month of Av —is a fast day and a day of mourning that commemorates the destruction of both the first and second Temples in Jerusalem, both of which were destroyed on the ninth of Av, roughly 655 years apart. It is also appropriate on this day to recall many of the other tragedies of the Jews that occurred on this day, most notably the expulsion of the Jews from Spain in 1492 and from England in 1290.

## Jewish-Themed film showing at New Hope Film Festival

The film *An Unknown Country* will be shown during the New Hope Film Festival at noon on Sunday July 22 at the New Hope Arts Center 2 Stockton Ave. The film, nominated for a 2018 New York Emmy Award for Best Documentary, tells the story of European Jews who escaped Nazi persecution and found refuge in an unlikely destination: Ecuador, a South American country barely known at the time. Featuring first-hand accounts and archival material, the film opens a window on the exiles' perilous escape and difficult adjustment as they remade their lives in what was for them an exotic, unfamiliar land.
